

Procedure for Application as Honorary Member of London Centre for Psychodrama

The MA in Psychodrama at Anglia Ruskin University is open to graduates of the London Centre for Psychodrama, whose training was validated for this purpose.

For graduates of **other training** schools in psychodrama, both in the UK and abroad we have the following system for evidencing equivalency:

1. Submission of qualifying Diploma in Psychodrama
2. Submission of current UKCP (or national equivalent) membership certificate
3. A list of essay titles and word count for written work that contributed to Diploma
4. The submission of a sample piece of academic writing that can be taken from one of the above, and including a reference list
5. A covering letter stating your interest in going forward for the MA
6. An interview, (which can be by Skype) with one or more members of the London Centre for Psychodrama teaching staff.
7. A BACS payment or cheque made out to London Centre for Psychodrama for the one off application fee of £400.

On successful completion of the process the applicant will be given an honorary certificate of membership of the London Centre for Psychodrama, which can be used on application to ARU through its website.
